

Unrecorded Millefiori Plaque from Silesia.

Introductory note.

In early 1830. Dr. Wilhelm Eduard Fuss joined Matteredne brothers in their Hoffnungsthal Glassworks in Silesian Riesengebirge mountains to reinvent 19th century millefiori art. His works resulted with some unique millefiori objects, with very few examples survived till today. Below is presented unrecorded example of Silesian millefiori plaque, made most probably by Dr. Fuss in Hoffnungsthal glassworks ca 1830. Very similar objects were made in neighboring Carlsthal glassworks just a bit later. Final attribution requires additional research - hope to share my results soon.
